Welcome back everyone to the 2020-2021 school year at Eleanor Hall School. We were excited to welcome back our returning students this week, as well as welcoming several new families to our school! We will dearly miss the families who have decided to enroll their students in Vista Virtual or a home schooling program for this school year.

As a staff, we have been incredibly proud of all of our students and how they have been handling the Covid-19 guidelines. They have been extremely cooperative, and are trying their very best. Thank you for all you have done to prepare your child for their return to school.

As a staff we have carefully studied the Alberta Health Services and Pembina Hills' Guidelines for a successful return to school and have refined and added to the guidelines that were sent out to you mid-August. We have included them in this newsletter and they are posted on our website.

Paper copies of newsletters will no longer be sent home. The youngest or only child in our school will receive a newsletter by email from their homeroom teacher. (This is the same procedure we used previously to send home paper copies). If you require a paper copy please let the classroom teacher know and one will be sent home to you.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions, we cancelled our Meet the Teacher and Awards Night. We will still be presenting the recipients with their awards, and are in the process of deciding how best to do this.

Our Terry Fox Run will be held on September 24th. It will be modified this year to allow for physical distancing and will take place near the end of the day. We will be collecting a 'Toonie for Terry' that we will forward to the Terry Fox Foundation rather than sending home a pledge form.

Orange Shirt Day-Every Child Matters, is September 30th. Orange Shirt Day is a legacy of the St. Joseph Mission residential school commemoration event held in Williams Lake, BC, in 2013. It grew out of Phyllis Webstad's story of having her shiny new orange shirt taken away on her first day of school at the Mission, and it has become an opportunity to keep the discussion on all aspects of residential schools happening annually. Please have your child wear orange on that day if possible.

Upcoming events at the beginning of October include Picture Day on October 6th and Goal Setting Evenings on October 7th and 8th.

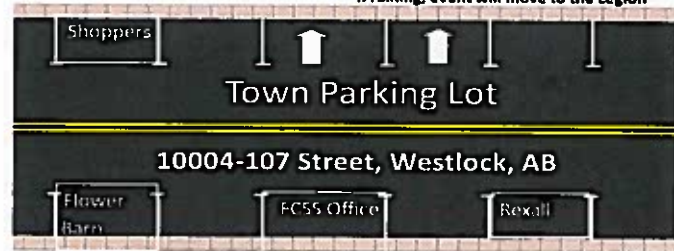

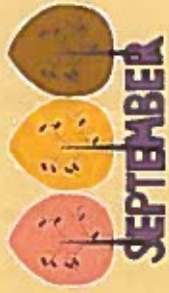
Kindergarten to Grade 5 2020/2021 Student Classroom Supplies

COVID-19 INFORMATION

Stay at Home Guide

A resource to help parents understand when they should keep their child home from school and when it's safe to return to class.

Most importantly: Students with symptoms **must not** attend school



DAILY HEALTH CHECK

You must screen your child for symptoms each day before school.

The Daily Health Check screening tool is available at www.pembinahills.ca

How long do students have to stay home?

If your child has ANY of these symptoms:

- Fever
- Cough (new cough or worsening chronic cough)
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing (new or worsening)
- Runny nose
- Sore throat

Here's what you need to do

You are **legally** required to have your child isolate for at least **10 days** from the start of their symptoms or until they resolve, whichever is longer.

Returning to school

Your child may return to school:

- once the 10-day isolation is complete **OR**
- when your child has received a negative COVID-19 test result **AND** symptoms have resolved.

TIP - If your child gets tested for COVID-19, the quickest way to receive results is by **text message**.

If your child has ANY of these symptoms:

- Chills
- Painful swallowing
- Stuffy nose
- Headache
- Muscle or joint aches
- Feeling unwell, fatigue or severe exhaustion
- Gastrointestinal symptoms (nausea, vomiting, diarrhea or unexplained loss of appetite)
- Loss of sense of smell or taste
- Conjunctivitis (pink eye)

Here's what you need to do

You must keep your child home from school until symptoms resolve. You should also minimize their contact with others until symptoms resolve.

Returning to school

Your child may return to school once symptoms have resolved. There is no need to get a COVID-19 test.
