## Principal's Message

November 2022

I cannot believe how quickly the first two months have flown by! The teachers really enjoyed speaking with you during the Goal Setting Meetings in October! A special thank you to the Enhancement Society for providing the staff with delicious meals both nights. We truly appreciated it!

Thank you for your support of our Scholastic Book Fair and our Little Caesar's Fundraiser! We will receive \$1900 in free books, and earned approximately \$1600 from Little Caesar's.

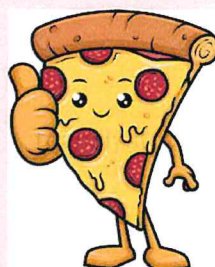

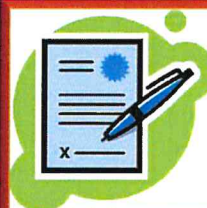


## Caesar Pizza Kit Fundraiser
