





 - a. School council responsibilities are outlined in the Education Act and School Council Regulation including: advising the principal and the board respecting any matter relating to the school; consulting with the principal so that the principal may ensure that students in the school have the opportunity to meet the standards of education set by the Minister; consulting with the principal so that the principal may ensure that the fiscal management of the school is in accordance with the requirements of the board and the superintendent; establishing and implementing policies in the school that the school council considers necessary to carry out its functions; making bylaws governing its meetings and the conduct of its affairs; advising on the development of school education plans, annual education results reports and budget; and completing and providing an annual report to the school board summarizing its activities and detailing the receipt, handling and use of any money in the previous school year.
 - b. Review roles & responsibilities of school councils, principals, teachers, school board
 - c. Motion to adopt a "Town Hall" style for our meetings, where any parent of a student in the school can vote at a school council meeting

8. Election of 2023-24 School Council Executive:

- a. **Chair:** needs to be a parent of a student attending the school, work collaboratively, and organize both programs and people. The typical chair duties include:
 - Chair all meetings of the school council
 - Establish the meeting agendas in coordination with the school principal
 - Regular & ongoing communication with the school principal
 - Ensure that operating procedures are current and followed
 - Be the official spokesperson of the school council
 - Ensure there is regular communication with the school community
 - Stay informed about school board policy that impacts school council
 - Provide the school Board with an annual report that summarizes the school council's activities for the previous school year, including a financial statement
- **b. Vice-Chair:** in the event of resignation, incapacity, or a leave of absence of the chair to fulfill the chair's responsibilities, supervise the affairs of the school council and preside at the school council meetings.
- **c. Secretary:** records notes at each meeting and ensures the minutes are prepared accurately to reflect the directions agreed to at the meeting.
