Babysitter Safety



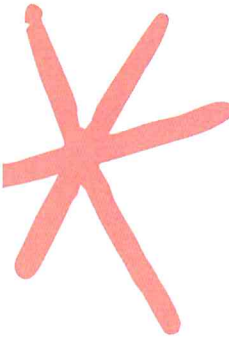
