Dear Parents and Guardians,

The grade 4-9 classes will be going skiing at Tawatinaw Valley Ski Hill on Friday, February. 20, 2026 (Weather Permitting).

Prices are as follows:

Ski/Snowboard Package - \$37 (package includes lift ticket, lesson, ski/snowboard equipment & helmet)

Lift Ticket Only - \$24 (lift ticket & lesson)

Equipment Rental Only - \$14

Please note that ALL students must wear a helmet.

EVERYONE MUST fill out three forms.

1. **Student Information Form** attached (EVEN if your child is NOT participating) and RETURN them to school as soon as possible.
2. **Online Tawatinaw Ski Hill Waiver** for each student. **Please DO NOT fill out rental information if your child will not be renting equipment.** The link can be found here: [Parent Link](#) (please see your email for the link)
3. **Eleanor Hall School Online Consent Form** through your Power School Parent Portal under the Payments, Consent & Transp Forms tab. Fees for packages, lift and equipment can be paid here online as well or by debit machine in the school office.

We will need all forms and payments into the office no later than Monday, February 16, 2026 at noon.

There will be a bus taking us to the hill and back for end of the day buses.

If you are transporting your child to and from the hill, we ask that you let the school office know before hand, so that the buses are not waiting for your child. Thank you!

There will be a teacher driving their own vehicle to the hill so if your child has their own equipment it can be transported to and from the hill. Please have it at the school by 8:30 am and then be at the school to pick up the equipment by 3:30 pm.

Tawatinaw Valley has a concession with different items if students wish to buy lunch, (meals will cost an average of \$10 - \$15 per student) but students are welcome to bring a bagged lunch as well.
